WAITING POOL SEPTEMBER 2018

All places for 1st Year in September 2018 have been filled.

We have opened a Waiting Pool, which will be kept in the event there are any withdrawals of places allocated to people and space becomes available for September 2018.

For parents who applied for a place for their children in the school on or before the closing date (28th October 2016) please note that the priority accorded to your child following random selection, within the relevant category, is retained. However, if you do not wish the school to retain your child's details please inform the Admissions Officer, by email (to admissions2018@templecarrigschool.ie) or by post (to Temple Carrig School, Greystones, Co. Wicklow), that you wish to have your child's name removed.

For parents/guardians who did not apply for a place for their children in the school for September 2018 on or before the closing date, Late Application Forms are available on request from the Admissions Officer by email (to admissions2018@templecarrigschool.ie) or in writing (to Temple Carrig School, Greystones, Co. Wicklow). If you have already submitted a late application you do not need to do so again.

At intervals between now and September 2018, if places become available they will be allocated from the Waiting Pool. The 2018 Waiting Pool is sorted by category from 0 to 5. Priority will be accorded to children in Category 0 then sequentially to each subsequent category. Within each category, preference is given to those applicants who applied on time (i.e. on or before 28th October 2016) but have not yet been offered a place.

Late Applicants, also sorted by category from 0 to 5, are eligible for an offer of a place once all those who applied on time *within that category* have been accommodated. Offers for Late Applicants are made by random selection.

The categories are as follows:

Category 0: Children of permanent teachers and staff of Temple Carrig Secondary School.

Category 1: Children from the following schools who permanently reside in the Greystones/Delgany catchment area (as delineated by area of the Church of Ireland parishes of Greystones and Delgany) at the date of application:

Gaelscoil na gCloch Liath
Educate Together NS Greystones
St Brigid's NS Greystones
St Laurence's NS Greystones
St Kevin's NS Greystones
Delgany NS
St Patrick's NS Greystones
Greystones CNS

The number of places to be allocated to children from Category 1 for admission in September 2018 shall not exceed 132.

Category 2: Children other than those coming within Categories 1 or 0 who permanently reside in the area covered by the Church of Ireland parishes of Greystones, Delgany, Bray, Newcastle with Newtownmountkennedy and Calary, and Powerscourt with Kilbride and attend any of the following primary schools under the patronage of the Church of Ireland at the date of application:

St Patrick's NS, Greystones
Delgany NS
St Andrew's NS Bray
Powerscourt NS, Enniskerry
St Francis NS, Newcastle

Category 3: Children who permanently reside in the Greystones/Delgany catchment area, at the date of application, who do not attend the schools listed in Categories 1 or 2.

Category 4: Children who permanently reside in the area covered by the Church of Ireland parishes of Bray, Newcastle with Newtown-mountkennedy and Calary and Powerscourt with Kilbride and attend the following primary schools at the date of application:

Educate Together NS Greystones
St Brigid's NS Greystones
St Laurence's NS Greystones
St Kevin's NS Greystones
Greystones CNS

Category 5: All other children.

The total number of places to be allocated to children for admission in September 2018 as determined by the Board of Management shall not exceed 144.
